

## **FACT SHEET: Native American Teacher/Community Leader Scholarships 2014 Idyllwild Arts Summer Program - Workshops for Adults**

The Idyllwild Arts Summer Program offers workshops for adults and youth in Native American arts and cultures, ceramics, painting, photography, creative writing, filmmaking, dance, theater, and music, on our beautiful campus in the San Jacinto Mountains of Southern California. Exhibits, lectures, demonstrations and performances complement these programs throughout the summer.

The Native American Teacher/Community Leader Scholarship is designed for adults 18 and over, with current tribal affiliation. The purpose of this scholarship fund is to bring teachers and community leaders to workshops at Idyllwild Arts to benefit both the scholarship recipients themselves as well as those in their schools and/or tribal communities when they return home. Applicants with financial need are given priority. The expenses covered by the scholarship include tuition, lab fee, registration fee, dorm housing, and all meals in the campus dining hall. The recipients are responsible for their transportation to and from campus. Idyllwild Arts is located between Palm Springs and Riverside.

To apply, send a letter of interest, a copy of your 2013 Federal Tax Return, and a completed Summer Program Registration form. The letter should include:

1. Reason for applying: explain why you would like to attend the program, how you would expect to benefit from it, and how your community and/or students would benefit from your experience.
2. Brief biographical statement (one or two paragraphs) to include your current position (teacher, etc.), your background and/or interest in the study of visual art (or the subject you wish to study at Idyllwild Arts), and any other pertinent information.
3. All personal contact information (mailing address, phone number, email address)

To ensure that there is space in the workshop you select and in campus housing, we recommend that you apply as soon as possible. Applications will be accepted beginning February 1, 2014.
